Report Type	Results	Response Type	Report Style
Pre-Op ECG	Heart rate, rhythm, and any contraindications for anesthesia (if applicable).	Phone call from our technicians within 1 hour (usually immediately after transmission) relaying the results from one of our specialists, followed by a report.	Concise
Screening ECG	Heart rate, rhythm, and any abnormalities; best suited for routine checks of geriatric and pre-chemotherapy patients. This is NOT recommended for patients with heart murmurs or known heart disease. This is OK for pre-heartworm treatment.	Same as Pre-Op.	Concise (similar to pre-op)
Routine Fax ECG	Full evaluation including assessment, and various recommendations.	If transmitted before 3pm EST – you will receive a faxed report by the next business day. If transmitted after 3pm EST – you will receive a faxed report by the end of the next business day.	Complete
Routine Phone ECG	Full evaluation including assessment, and various recommendations.	If transmitted before 3pm EST – you will receive a phone call by one of our specialists by the end of the day. A report will follow. If transmitted after 3pm EST – you will receive a phone call by the afternoon of the next business day. A faxed will follow.	Complete
STAT ECG	Full evaluation including assessment, and various recommendations.	If transmitted before 5pm EST - You will receive a phone call by one of our specialists within one hour of transmitting. A report will follow. If transmitted after 5pm EST – You will receive a phone call by one of our specialists within one hour of opening the next business day. A report will follow	Complete
Code Red ECG	Full evaluation including assessment, and various recommendations.	If transmitted before 5:30 pm EST - You will receive a phone consultation immediately after transmitting. A report will follow. If transmitted after 5:30 pm EST – Contact our staff for estimated phone consultation response time. A report will follow.	Complete
